




VIEWCREST PARKING


The Homes is working with the Unified Government to turn part of Viewcrest into a one way. This will allow one side of the street to have angled parking instead of parallel parking. This will allow almost 3 angled parking spaces for every one parallel space. This will increase parking that is greatly needed. The one-way would affect units 1-88 Viewcrest. The one way will stop before the intersection of Summitcrest and Viewcrest. The following drawings show the

different choices. The UG is recommending **A-1** and **B-1**. Drivers would back into parking spots. Backing into a parking space (reverse parking) is generally considered safer than pulling forward into it, especially when leaving the space. The primary reason is that when exiting a reverse parking space, you can see what's in front of you, making it easier to navigate without blind spots. Conversely, pulling forward into a space and then backing out can be more dangerous due to limited visibility and increased risk of collisions with other vehicles or pedestrians.









The one-way change will be discussed at the next Board Meeting. Once the changes are approved a letter will be sent to all residents informing them of the changes. The city will post signage and stripe out the new spaces. If you would like to see the drawings at a larger scale stop by the clubroom.

The next one-way change will focus on Roswell. One side of the street will have angled parking instead of parallel parking. This will allow almost 3 angled parking spaces for every one parallel space. This will increase the parking that is greatly needed. More drawings will be provided along with the UG's recommendations.
